**Public Forum**

The Chairman confirmed that the Parish Council were aware of this issue however covert cameras had been installed by Lincolnshire County Council's Highways department on two occasions previously and the findings did not confirm that speeding was an issue. The members of the council stated that they had exhausted all avenues open to them and advised the member of the public to contact the Community Speed Watch scheme for further advice.
